

Trinity Historical Society – The Loyal Trinity Volunteer Ranger Award Call for Nominations

Trinity Historical Society collects and preserves records, manuscripts, and buildings of enduring value, related to the history of the Trinity Bight area and its citizens. The Loyal Trinity Volunteer Ranger Award is an annual award (2022 being the inaugural year) recognizing a person, past or present, who has demonstrated a commitment to the promotion and preservation of our collective heritage.

The Loyal Trinity Volunteer Ranger Award is named after the *Loyal Trinity Volunteer Rangers* who were formed during the war of 1812 under the command of William Kelson to defend Trinity Harbour and the nearby towns. Many of the restored armaments found at Fort Point were due to this effort and fort reactivation.

Award Ceremony:

The award will be presented to the recipient at the annual Trinity Historical Society Auction. This year being on Friday, August 19, 2022.

Award Description:

The Loyal Trinity Volunteer Ranger Award recipient will receive a plaque with the name, date and THS crest. A photo of the recipient, accompanied by a description of their contribution, will be hung in Lester Garland House for one year, and published in the Trinity Bight Enterprise and THS Newsletter.

Proposed Municipal Plan and Development Regulations Amendment

The Town Council of Trinity is considering an amendment to the Trinity Municipal Plan and Development Regulations. In accordance with Section 14 of the *Urban and Rural Planning Act*, Council is seeking input from residents on the proposed amendments.

Council wishes to change the land use designation and zoning of properties along the southeastern side of Railway Road from Rural to Mixed Development. The purpose of the change would be to permit the development of a proposed dwelling at Civic No. 19 Railway Road and also include other similarly developed properties along the street. The area under consideration is indicated on the map below.

Residents are requested to notify Council in writing, mail, facsimile or email, by July 15,2022 of any questions, comments or objections to the proposed Change.



- 1. Name of nominee
- Address of nominee
- 3. Name of Nominator, with addresses and contact information
- 4. Provide a nomination statement indicating how long you have known the nominee and the reasons you believe this nominee is a worthy candidate. The statement should be typed and should not exceed one page. (Approximately 500 words)
- 5. Any additional material to support the nomination such as publications, media stories, tributes, work produced, etc.

Award Selection:

A committee of two Trinity Historical Society board members will review the nominations and recommend the recipient to the board for ratification.



The Trinity Historical Society (THS) is pleased to report that Robyn Lacy and lan Petty from Black Cat Cemetery Preservation completed two weeks of work on the restoration of the headstones in St. Paul's Churchyard on May 20th. During this time, they up righted, reset, repaired, and cleaned 75 headstones. The cost for Black Cat to perform this work was \$14,669.78, in addition to the cost of two loads of crusher dust which we supplied on site. The total amount of funds raised for this project up to this time is \$26,848.75. Robyn and Ian will return for a third week of work on the headstones on June 20th. Once again, we would like to thank Corey Jones for providing accommodation for them at Trinity Cabins. Further work to complete the restoration of the remaining headstones will depend on our ability to raise additional funds for the project.

We have received the hard copies of "From Fisher's Cove, Trinity. Poetry and Prose by siblings Rose Sullivan and George Hoskins". Rose and George were born and raised in Trinity. The book is a delightful read and is available for purchase at the Lester Garland Giftshop. There will be a book launch at the Lester Garland House on July 19th from 7-9 pm with readings by Ruth Lawrence and Des Walsh.

As always, the THS welcomes application for membership from anyone interested in the objectives and activities of the Society.

In this edition of our Newsletter, we present the story of the 17th of the men whose names are inscribed on the War Monument in St. Paul's Churchyard.

Regiment April 30, 1917. He joined the battalion in France on February 15, 1918 and lost his life on October 14, 1918. He was 29.





Family Tree

Wilfred, a clerk before enlisting, quickly rose to the rank of Company Sergeant Major while still in training in Scotland, a testament to his leadership qualities. He was killed in action and was interred on the battlefield at a point northeast of Ledegem, Belgium. His remains were later exhumed and interred at Dadizeele New British Cemetery, Moorslede, Belgium. He is also remembered on the war memorial located in New-West-Valley, his birth place.

Wilfred Barbour, the son of George Barbour and Lucretia Jane Oakley, was born at Newtown on October 3, 1889. He enlisted in the Royal Newfoundland
